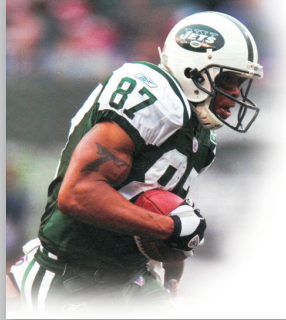

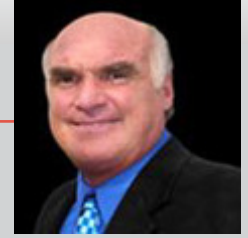
Jacksonville at Philadelphia

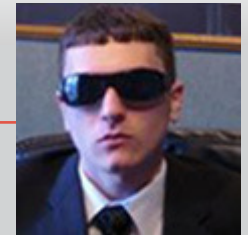
Cleveland at Green Bay

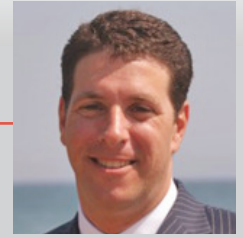
New Orleans at New England

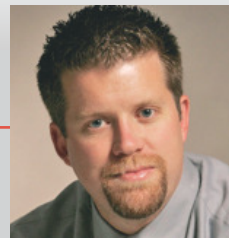
Pittsburgh at San Diego (MLB)

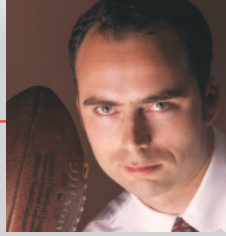
Oakland at Dallas

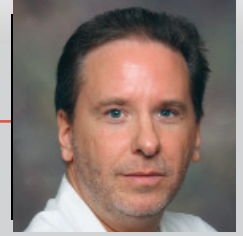
Tampa Bay at Miami

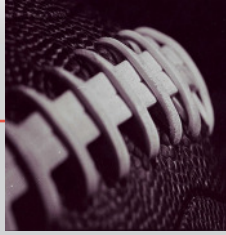

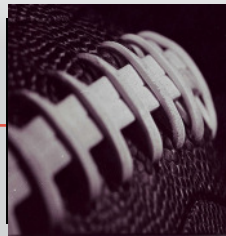
Tampa Bay at Miami

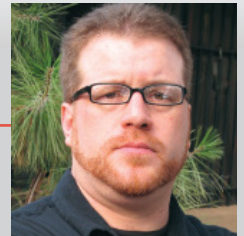
Oakland at Dallas


