The nightcap is the New Orleans Bowl, which is Ohio of the MAC against Troy of the Sun Belt. Ohio has never won a bowl game in its history and for the first time ever is in the postseason in consecutive seasons. Troy has won a share of its conference title each of the last five years and will be looking to win this game for a second straight season as they beat Southern Miss last year 42-32 as three-point dogs. Oddsmakers have them favored by a point and a half.

Bowl season kicks off with the New Mexico Bowl at 2 PM ET Saturday with BYU taking on UTEP. Brigham Young is one of the bigger favorites of the entire bowl season, currently laying 11.5 points. However, this was a down year for the Cougars and note that the big favorite lost in this bowl game this year. This is the first time in six years that BYU will not be playing in the Las Vegas Bowl, a game they went 3-2 SU/ATS in. Meanwhile, this is UTEP's first bowl appearance since '05.

The final game we'll cover this week is next Tuesday's St. Petersburg Bowl between Louisville and Southern Miss. The Cardinals of L'ville are laying three points at the betting window in this one. The Golden Eagles are a perennial bowl participant while Louisville makes its first postseason appearance since '07. This is a classic battle of offense vs. defense with Southern Miss the 15th highest scoring team in the nation and Louisville ranking 11th in total defense.

Up next is the Humanitarian Bowl which pits Northern Illinois from the MAC against Fresno State from the WAC. The

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### Jacksonville at Indianapolis Sunday, December 19, 1:00 EST

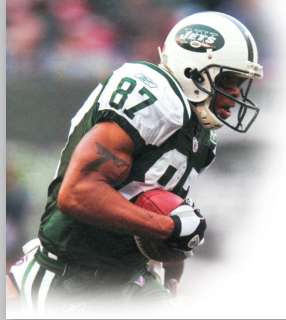
Believe it or not, Jacksonville is sitting on top of the AFC South with an 8-5 record one game ahead of the Colts. This game is all or nothing for Indy they are currently two games behind the Ravens and Jets in the wildcard race and a loss will put them two games out, but virtually three as the Jags would hold the tie breaker. Most remember the first meeting between these two squads down in Jacksonville in early October. The Colts rode into north Florida as 6.5-point favorites and left on the wrong side of a 31-28 score. Peyton Manning was his usual self completing 33 of 46 passes for 348 yards. However, the Colts defense couldn't stop Jacksonville as the Jags ran for 174 yards and Garrard completed 17 of 22 passes for 163 yards. Jacksonville also won the turnover margin as they forced two Indy turnovers while not turning the ball over a single time. Not sure there's another quarterback that you would want on the field in big game like this other than Peyton Manning. However, he can't do it all by himself. Due to their defensive weaknesses he's been forced to come from behind and try to outscore the other team. The Colts have allowed over 30 points per game the last four contests. But, the Colts and Manning are very good in a revenge situation in which they allowed 28 or more points posting a 27-13 ATS record. **3\* Play on Indy**

Their offense wasn't spectacular as they put up only 286 total yards but their defense held Green Bay to only 258 total yards. It didn't hurt that they knocked Green Bay QB Rodgers out of the game in the second quarter. Tampa Bay got a lucky win last Sunday thanks to Washington blowing the game tying extra point. 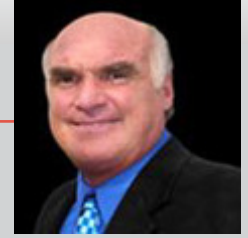
**NY Jets at Pittsburgh**
