## In Need of a Rehearsal

**Y**ou probably don't have to be told that the third game of the NFL Preseason is known as “dress rehearsal” week. This is where the first-teamers will see their only significant playing time during the exhibition campaign. The action starts Thursday with the 2-0 Patriots hosting the Rams and the Packers welcoming in the 0-2 Colts. New England's lack of a pass rush shouldn't hurt them too much against a weak St. Louis offensive line while Indianapolis remains a terrible play in the preseason as Peyton Manning never plays. The Colts, just 2-9 SU and 3-8 ATS their last eleven preseason games overall, have been extra-bad this preseason, losing by a combined 33 points, which is the worst margin of defeat amongst the 32 teams. They are currently just a 3.5-point dog for this matchup with Green Bay.

Another team that looks to be in trouble this preseason is Arizona. The retirement of Kurt Warner has left a huge void at quarterback that neither Matt Leinart nor Derek Anderson has been able to fill. Yes, the Cardinals managed to win their opener (19-16 over Houston), but they trailed that game 16-0 through three quarters and then

found themselves down 24-3 last Monday to Tennessee. Under the direction of Leinart, the offense went three-and-out on all three possessions last week. This week Arizona is at 0-2 Chicago, who will be favored despite two losses by a combined 30 points thus far.

Brett Favre should play more than four downs Saturday night when his team hosts Seattle. New Seahawks HC Pete Carroll has done little to eradicate the notion that he's in over his head at the NFL level thus far. Coming into this year, Seattle was on a 10-0 ATS preseason run, but this year they're 0-2 ATS.

### Atlanta at Miami Friday, August 27, 7:00 EST

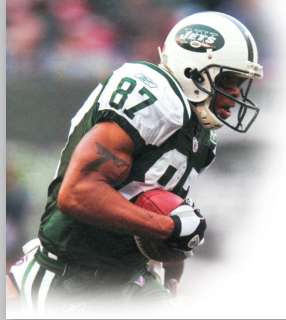

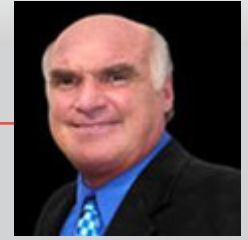
Washington at NY Jets
