Baltimore at Philadelphia Thursday, August 11 7:30 EST

The Eagles are the talk of the NFL with their big free agent signings. Meanwhile the Ravens have taken flack regarding whether or not they can get to the Super Bowl with their QB Joe Flacco. Philadelphia coach Andy Reid doesn't put much stock into these preseason games, but despite this lack of interest the Eagles still managed to win two of their four preseason games last year, but they were only 1-3 ATS. The Ravens were 3-1 SU and ATS last season, but they were a perfect 3-0 SU and ATS in the first three weeks. In those three wins the Ravens once again demonstrated their top rated defense allowing only 25 total points.

These two teams met in the preseason four straight years from 2004 – 2007, however they haven't squared off since. Baltimore holds a 7-3 SU and 6-3-1 ATS advantage over the last 10 meetings. In those last 10 meetings eight have gone under the posted total. Betonline.com opened the Eagles as 3.5 point favorites but the public has bet down the number to Philadelphia as 2.5-point choice. The current total is at 34 points. Not only has this been an under series, Baltimore has been a very strong under bet in the preseason posting a 21-8 under record in their last 29 preseason games. Offenses should be a bit rusty in this first week of the NFLX.

Arizona at Oakland Thursday, August 11, 10:00 EST

Here's a time-tested preseason betting angle: take a new head coach in his 1st home game. Hue Jackson is now the man in charge in Oakland and he takes over a Raiders team that actually went 8-8 last year, including 6-0 in the division. He has a pretty good QB in Jason Campbell, who still has something to prove. Campbell will be getting a new offensive coordinator this season in Al Saunders, but he has some familiarity with him from their days

together in Washington.

Arizona is being tabbed to win the weak NFC West in the wake of acquiring QB Kevin Kolb from Philadelphia. However, the abbreviated training camp is going to have a negative effect, at least early on, for a Cardinals group that pretty much gutted its QB position from a season ago.

This is a pretty short line to work with for the favored Raiders, who are 4-0 ATS at home in the preseason when the total is 35 or less. The Cardinals averaged just 12 points per game on the road last year in the preseason with an equally jumbled mess under center. Arizona is also just 2-5 straight up its last seven preseason games with the Silver and Black. Look for Jackson to pick up an easy win and cover in his home debut.

Tampa Bay at Kansas City Friday, August 12, 8:00 ET

The Kansas City Chiefs have been absolutely awful in the preseason under head coach Todd Haley, losing seven straight games before winning the meaningless finale last year, 17-13 over eventual Super Bowl Champion Green Bay as four-point favorites. In those seven losses, Kansas City was a dreadful 0-7 against the spread.

One of those losses came last year against Tampa Bay, whom they open the preseason against this year. Despite playing backups Josh Johnson and Rudy Carpenter (starting QB Freeman got hurt) the vast majority of the game, the Bucs won 20-15 and covered as two-point favorites. Kansas City ran 28 more plays than Tampa Bay in the game, but committed three turnovers.

We have already seen a significant line move for this game as obviously we're not the only ones who are aware of Kansas City's preseason struggles. After opening as small two-point favorites, you can now bet the Chiefs at +3 at BetOnline.com. We are not taking the bait. Tampa Bay brings home the money in the preseason opener.

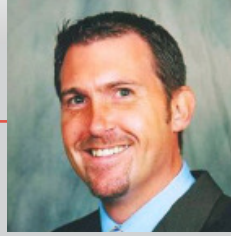
Baltimore at Philadelphia

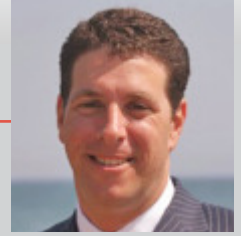
Green Bay at Cleveland

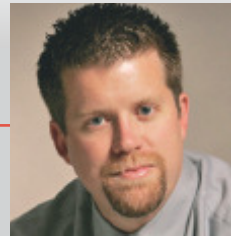


Washington at Chicago

While Wrigley Field is no piece of cake, facing the current version of the Cubs should be a lot easier for Detwiler and his teammates than going up against the Rockies and the Nats hitters could have a field day when they face righthander Rodrigo Lopez who gave up six runs in four innings in his last start against the Pirates and who has struggled as a starter this season with a 5.54 ERA in seven games in that capacity. Detwiler's one and only win of the season was in his first start and it was against this Cubs team, albeit at home.

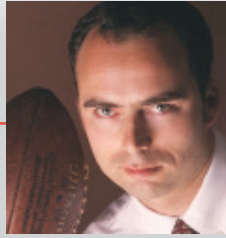


Arizona at Houston

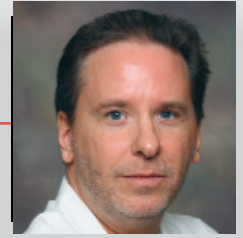
Indianapolis at St Louis

Collmenter throws his change with an over the top motion -- which looks exactly like his fastball. Early in the season he had a huge advantage. But now teams have seen him -- have been able to study him on tape, and he has been less effective. Collmenter has been tagged for 5 earned runs or more in four of his last seven starts.

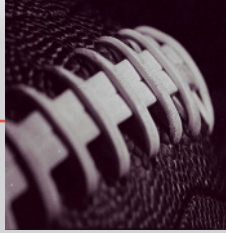


Miami at Atlanta

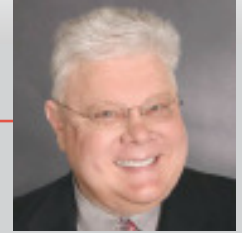


Green Bay at Cleveland

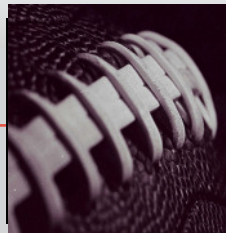
Baltimore at Philadelphia
