## Hitting The Quarter Mark

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**W**e've reached Week 4 of the 2011 NFL Season which means after Monday, a quarter of this year's game will have already been played. Bye weeks will start coming into play in Week 5 as for six straight weeks there will not be a full slate of NFL games.

There are three unbeatens after three weeks. One is defending Super Bowl Champion Green Bay, which is no surprise. The other two are Buffalo and Detroit, which are huge surprises considering neither has made the playoffs in the last decade. Last season, there were also three teams that started the year 3-0 (Chicago, Kansas City and Pittsburgh). All three lost in Week 4.

It would be a major surprise to see Green Bay fail to get to 4-0 as the Packers are massive double digit favorites Sunday at home vs. struggling Denver. Note that Green Bay is 7-1 ATS when on a 3-game win streak. Buffalo is the first team in league history to come back from 18-point deficits in back to back weeks, stunning the Patriots outright last week (5\* EDGE WINNER). Will they suffer a letdown this week as three-point favorites in Cincinnati? Check out page 2 for the answer!

Detroit is 3-0 for the first time since 1980 and is an underdog at Dallas, who is now 1-9 ATS as a favorite.

Five teams are winless entering Week 4 (Kansas City, Indianapolis, St. Louis, Minnesota and Miami). We have some bad news for these losers as last year there were also five winless teams entering Week 4 and only one emerged victorious. That is guaranteed to happen again this year as the Vikings are favored at Kansas City. The Colts are hapless without Peyton Manning and are a 10-point dog at Tampa Bay Monday night. St. Louis is favored at home vs. Washington and we have the winner for you in this matchup on page 2. Miami is a 7.5-point dog at San Diego. The Chargers, along with the Rams, are the only teams currently 0-3 ATS.

There is only one 3-0 ATS team in the league. Who is it? The Oakland Raiders.

Our NFL EDGE picks swept the board last week, going a perfect 3-0 ATS, including the Bills and Giants outright. Be sure to check out this week's NFL and College winners.

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### Washington at St. Louis Sunday, Oct. 2nd, 1:00 ET

The Redskins suffered their first loss of the season Monday night, losing at Dallas 18-16. They did manage to cover for their backers as a 3.5-point underdog. Now, on a short week, they must hit the road again to play a desperate 0-3 St. Louis team that almost has to win here heading into the bye week.

St. Louis is 0-3 SU/ATS and has been blown out in both home games so far. But that was against two 'elite' clubs – Philadelphia and Baltimore – while they were dealing with multiple injuries. Their other loss came in that Monday night game vs. the Giants where New York was accused of faking injuries to slow up the St. Louis' no-huddle offense. They were competitive against the Eagles, but not so much vs. the Ravens, losing 37-7 last week. Look for a bounce back though as the Rams are 5-1 ATS when off a loss by 28 points or more.

No team was dealt a tougher schedule to start the year than St. Louis. After the bye, they are at Green Bay, at Dallas, then host New Orleans. This may be their only shot at a win in the first seven games. Not buying the Redskins' quick start as they still have Rex Grossman at QB and he can't be trusted on the road.

### Buffalo at Cincinnati Sunday, Oct. 2nd, 1:00 ET

The Bills were a nice 5\* winner for us last week in the EDGE as they stunned the Patriots, winning outright 34-31 as 7.5-point home underdogs. It was a game they trailed 21-0 early and quite frankly we were looking for the remote and a napkin to wipe all that egg off our face. Then, unbelievably, the game turned with the Bills exploding for a second straight week in the second half. Bit of trivia for you folks here: Not only did Buffalo snap a 15-game

losing streak vs. New England, the Bills are the first team to erase 18-point deficits in consecutive weeks since since 1950.

This week is a clear letdown spot on the road against the Bengals. Eventually, the magic has to run out. Playing against NFL favorites off an outright win over a division rival as a home dog, that have a winning record on the season, results in a 75% winning percentage, going 33-11 ATS since 1983. The Bills are not accustomed to the road favorite role.

Additionally, Cincinnati has been competitive in both losses so far, losing by two and five points. We like them plus the points this week at home.

### NY Giants at Arizona Sunday, Oct. 2nd, 4:05 ET

All of a sudden everyone is back on this Giants bandwagon following back to back wins over St. Louis and Philadelphia. We had them as a nice 3\* outright winner last week over the Eagles. It was a nice 29-16 victory for the team as 8-point underdogs.

Arizona is heading in the opposite direction right now with back to back losses. Last week was a bad loss losing outright as road favorites at a poor Seattle team.

There is some good news potentially on the horizon with the Cards 37-18 ATS at home off back to back losses and 13-4 ATS at home off a division loss by seven points or less. Both of their losses have been close – coming by a combined four points – but they simply can't afford a third loss in a row, even in this terrible NFC West.

After going with the G-Men last week, we are going against them here and don't be surprised to see them lose this game outright. Road teams off an outright win by double digits as an underdog, with a winning record on the season, are just 58-101 ATS since 1983. The Cards are back home off back to back road losses and should get the job done against what is still an injury-riddled New York team.

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### Northwestern at Illinois Saturday, Oct. 1st, 12:00 ET

Entering the fifth weekend of the 2011 College Football season, there are still 21 unbeaten teams in the nation. Four of them reside in the Big 10 and the biggest surprise out of the quartet has to be Illinois. The Illini are off back to back three-point victories over Arizona State and Western Michigan, barely covering against the former and not being so fortunate against the latter. They have yet to play a road game all season, which may actually not be a bad thing considering they are just 22-19 SU in Champaign under Ron Zook and 44-66 ATS here since '92.

This week, they are at home again, taking on in-state rival Northwestern. The Wildcats have revenge in this matchup for a 48-27 loss at Wrigley Field last season. That was their first game playing without injured QB Dan Persa, who has not played since. The good news is Persa is expected to make his 2011 debut this week as Northwestern had last week off following an outright loss to Army. Northwestern went just 2-4 SU in six games without Persa and one of those wins came against Eastern Illinois. With Persa, the team started 7-3 SU last year.

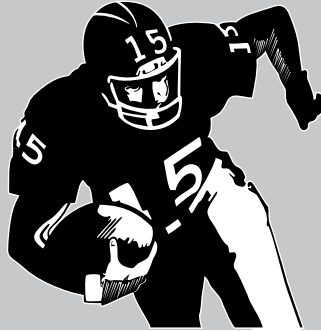
Don't like the Illini laying this many points in this matchup as they are just 9-21 ATS as chalk of 3.5 to 10 points. They are also 2-7 ATS on a winning streak of four or more games. Revenge, a bye week and the return of Persa all leads to a Northwestern cover (and possible outright win). **5\* Northwestern.**

### Georgia Tech at NC State Saturday, Oct. 1, 3:30 ET

We all got a look at this North Carolina State team last Thursday and quite frankly things didn't look very good as the Wolfpack got buried on the road by Cincinnati 44-14. They ran the ball 26 times and wound up with -22 yards! Tom O'Brien's team is now 0-4 ATS this season and 2-2 SU, although both losses came on the

This week, they are back in Raleigh to face unbeaten Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jackets are off a nice 35-28 home win over North Carolina in their ACC opener, a game many people pushed on. It was the first game Tech failed to score at least 49 points. They are 4-0 ATS to start the season, including a 66-24 win over Kansas two weeks ago.

Georgia Tech has typically done pretty well on the road in this series (7-1 ATS L8 trips) and has revenge for a 45-28 home loss last year as Wolfpack QB Wilson had a career day. Wilson has now transferred to Wisconsin and any hopes NC State had of having a good season went with him. ### Texas Tech at Kansas Saturday, Oct. 1, 12:00 ET

Texas Tech is another one of those 21 unbeaten teams entering October. But, who really believes in the Red Raiders? They opened the season with pretty 'ho-hum' wins over Texas State and New Mexico. Last week, they survived at home against Nevada, beating the Wolfpack 35-34 as

lofty 16-point favorites.

This week, they open Big 12 play on the road against Kansas. This will be an angry Jayhawks team after being embarrassed 66-24 in their last game vs. Georgia Tech. They allowed over 600 yards rushing in that game! Luckily, Turner Gill's team got last week off to sort out the issues. Strategically, this is a much different matchup against the pass-happy attack of the Red Raiders.

We are aware that Tech has never lost here in Lawrence in six tries. However, we also know that Tommy Tuberville's team has dropped six of its last eight conference road games and done so by an average of 22 points per game. We like the home dog coming off a bye and looking for redemption. **3\* Kansas.**

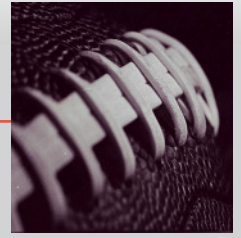


Texas at Iowa State

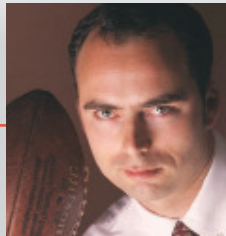

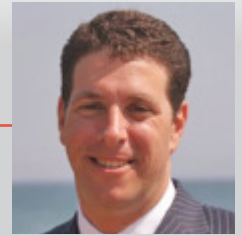
Hawaii at Louisiana Tech

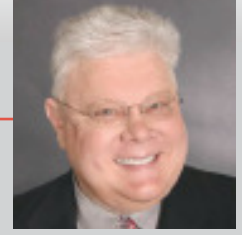


**Pittsburgh at Houston**

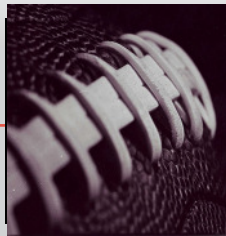
**New Orleans at Jacksonville**
